Monmouthshire County Council are proposing changes to secondary school catchment areas, as well as changes to the criteria used to award places in the event of over subscription.

The local authority are seeking to amend criteria with reference to the ordering of priority for sibling/catchment, and also the introduction of a feeder school policy at secondary level.

The local authority are also proposing changes to the secondary school catchment boundaries for Monmouth and King Henry VIII School. If agreed these proposals will be implemented from September 2020 and therefore it is the children and young people that are attending/living within the catchment areas for Goytre, Usk, Llandogo and Trellech primary schools that will be affected.
