Possible impact of attendance over an academic year

95% attendance – you will have missed nearly 10 days from school, 2 weeks, **50 hours of lessons.**

90% attendance = you will have missed nearly 20 days from school, 4 weeks, **100 hours of lessons.**

80% attendance = you will have missed nearly 40 days from school, 8 weeks, **200 hours of lessons.**

- October's attendance prizes go to the most improved attenders per year and 100% attenders for the month this week;
- November and December are key target weeks for attendance;
- This half-term, lots of prizes and awards will be given for good attendance;
- Parents can help by **trying to arrange appointments outside of school hours or only leaving school for the time of the appointment and returning and avoiding any days off through holidays.**
- **Pupils, try to keep yourselves happy and healthy through eating well, sleeping enough and maintaining good hygiene to avoid illness, colds and flu if at all possible.**

High levels of attendance improves wellbeing, increases confidence in learning, develops self-esteem, fosters social skills and prepares you for later life.

Attendance	What will happen (Outcomes)
Well Done 95% or Above Attendance	<p>WELL DONE your attendance is above the school target.</p> <p>You will be included in a list of year school trips, prizes and other attendance awards.</p> <p>This means that you have missed less than 10 days from school in a year. This level of attendance will help you achieve your potential in many areas and ensure you get the most from your education.</p> <p>Your form tutor will monitor your attendance as a regular task.</p>
Good Tutor 90 up to 95% Attendance	<p>You will meet with your Form Tutor to discuss concerns and arrange to help you improve your attendance.</p> <p>The attendance means that you have missed between 11 and 17 days of your education. If your attendance does not improve your potential to be able to reach your full potential in learning.</p> <p>Your teacher will meet with you and your parents to create an action plan to improve your attendance.</p>
Level of Learning 85 up to 90% Attendance	<p>Level of Learning will meet with you and your parents to create an action plan to improve your attendance.</p> <p>The attendance means that you have missed between 18 to 24 days of your education. If your attendance does not improve you will be referred to the Assistant Head or the Educational Welfare Officer.</p>
Concerned 80 up to 85% Attendance	<p>An Assistant Head will meet with you and your parents.</p> <p>The Assistant Head will create an action plan to improve your attendance, meeting with you regularly to monitor progress.</p> <p>This attendance means you have missed between 25 to 32 days of your education. If your attendance does not improve it may be referred to the Educational Welfare Officer.</p>
Worry 75% or Below Attendance	<p>You will necessarily be referred to the Educational Welfare Officer for monitoring and possibly the Governor Attendance Panel.</p> <p>Your attendance means that you have missed 33 or more days of your education. This will have a serious impact on your learning.</p> <p>Parents improve your attendance could be referred to the Governor Attendance Panel.</p>
