



## KHS Maths E—learning

What are we doing for e-learning?  
What are our expectations for learners?  
How are we using platforms?



This is our primary platform,  
used with **ALL** pupils at KHS.

- Teachers set work for pupils weekly (approximately one per timetabled lesson) . This includes a short video and a quiz made up of 5—15 questions.
- A minimum of one MemRi task is also expected a week (this will show as revision in “My tasks”).
- Pupils are expected to log onto Hegarty and complete these tasks.
- Teachers then write feedback comments to pupils to aid progression. Click [HERE](#) to see how to read and use feedback. (A teacher may reassign a task, if a pupil scores less than 70%, has not watched the video and has taken less than a few minutes on a task.)

Don't worry too much if you don't manage to complete everything each week

**Send a comment to your teacher if falling behind or stuck.**

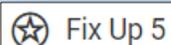
**Hegarty offers a number of additional tools to aid progression:**



MemRi

As you may have guessed MemRi is a tool to help your memory work at its best. It uses a quiz made up of questions from previously set tasks that you could do. This is great for keeping knowledge from slipping away and is incredibly helpful come test time.

Memri uses spaced learning to test pupils on topics they have covered previously. Spaced learning encourages recall and embeds knowledge in long term memory, reducing the need for crammed revision.



Fix Up 5

Fix up 5 creates a bank of questions that you got wrong previously. This encourages pupils to “fix” any previous errors ensuring improvement and progression.
