THE SCHOOL DAY

EQUIPMENT/UNIFORM

We know you work hard to make sure your child has the right equipment however there are times when they may forget things. As we are minimising visitors to reception thus reducing the risk of cross-infection, unless the forgotten item is essential we are asking your child does without this for one day.

If you have purchased equipment through Parent Pay, this will be delivered to the student during registration. We have also provided every student with their own mini white board pack to allow for interactive learning in the classroom. This will be theirs and it is expected they bring this to school every day.

MEDICAL AND DENTAL APPOINTMENTS / TERM TIME ABSENCES

Where ever possible these should occur outside of the school day. If you need to collect your child for an essential appointment during the school day please inform the school by email on info@khs.schoolsedu.org.uk. When you arrive on site please telephone reception on 01873 735374 and wait outside. Your child will sign out at reception. Once a student has left site they will be unable to return to school on that day.

HEALTH

As a school and local community it is important we all work together. We know all parents and guardians will check their child's health every morning prior to sending them to school. All staff will be vigilant for any visual changes to students' temperatures or signs of fever. Under no circumstances should a student attend school if they:

- feel unwell;
- have any of the identified COVID-19 symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste or smell);
- have tested positive to COVID-19 or live in a household or are part of an extended household with someone who has symptoms of, or has tested positive for COVID-19.

We would ask that our community takes a cautious approach and if in doubt please keep your child at home and arrange to have a test. This can be arranged online by following the <https://self-referral.test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/antigen/name>

Any child who has been sent home from school displaying one or more of the COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed to return until we have confirmation of a negative test result or 10 days isolation.
